

Wi-Fi Network Setup

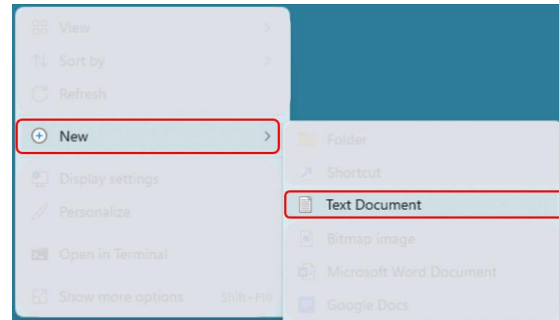
Creating a Password File Manually

1. Insert a USB flash drive into your computer.



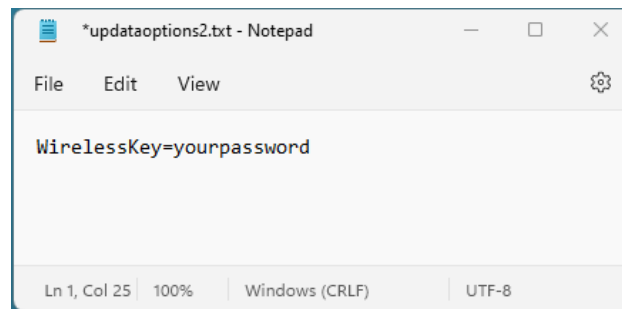
2. Right click on an empty space on the computer desktop.

3. Choose New > Text Document



4. Skip naming the file for now

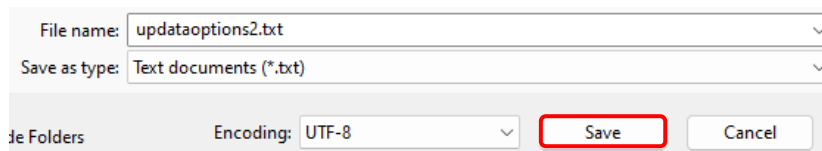
5. Open the file and type **WirelessKey=** followed by your network password. There should be no spaces, unless your network password includes a space.



6. File > Save As > Choose the USB drive

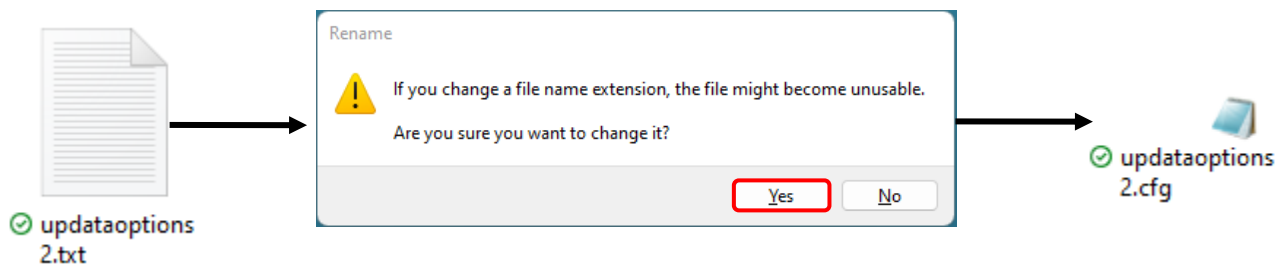
7. Name the file “**updataoptions2**” and keep it set to a .txt

8. Save



9. Exit the file and right click the icon and choose “Rename.”

10. Keep the file name the same, but replace the “.txt” with “.cfg” to create a configuration file



11. Safely eject the USB from your computer.

Double Check!

File is saved as **updataoptions2.cfg**

with contents: **WirelessKey= YourPassword.**
